My fellow West Virginians,

2025 will be remembered as the dawn of a New American Golden Age. 
On the House Appropriations Committee, I'm securing hundreds of millions of dollars for infrastructure investment and job creation. In this report, you will find a list of projects I've successfully included in the House's budget bills. Beyond these federal dollars for West Virginia, I'd like to share a few additional highlights from this year.

The new year, I expect, will bring a renewed federal focus, led by the Environment Protection Agency, on West Virginia communities struggling with water contamination. This investigation was launched because of an amendment I offered to the Department of the Interior budget. My argument showed other Members of Congress the raw images of life faced by many West Virginians – washing machines filled with black water and jars of "drinking water" tainted by brown contaminant.

As your representative, I've promoted West Virginia, especially our district, as a great place for companies to locate. In August, I brought one of the largest defense manufacturers in the world to North Central West Virginia Airport. My team and I are working toward historic development of our state's natural resources – companies looking to create jobs through investment in our coal, critical mineral, steelmaking, and manufacturing industries.

Our people are too often forgotten or ignored by Washington. That's why, when I took office on January 3rd, I directed my staff to prioritize making West Virginia's voices heard to bureaucrats. Since then, we have broken loose more than \$4 million from the federal government that was owed to the people of West Virginia. My inquiries resulted in the release of West Virginians held hostage by foreign governments, saved access to public drinking water for thousands of West Virginians, and more.

The Power of the Purse

Alongside Congressman Riley Moore, the House Appropriations Committee is advancing conservative legislation that protects our way of life and invests in rural communities like those in West Virginia.

- Prevents the Department of Justice from suing state or local governments over laws that protect the unborn.* ^{†1}
- Cares for our troops and their families by including a 3.8% raise in basic pay for all military personnel effective January 1, 2026.* ^{†2}
- Protects the homeland by empowering the Secretary of Agriculture to review agricultural transactions made by China, Russia, Iran, and others. ^{†3}
- Prevents “Environmental, Social, and Governance” (ESG) frameworks from being implemented at the Department of the Treasury.* ^{†4}
- Prohibits the use of funds in the bill to go towards the creation of a U.S. Central Bank Digital Currency.* ^{†4}
- Invests in protecting critical infrastructure against cyber attacks from hostile powers like the Chinese Communist Party.* ^{†5}
- Provides \$100 million for the Make America Healthy Again (MAHA) initiative, investing in prevention programs for rural communities, telehealth resources for chronic care, and nutrition services.* ^{†6}
- Maintains the longstanding Hyde Amendment and ensuring no federal funding can be used for abortion on demand.* ^{†6}



Putting West Virginia First

- An original cosponsor of H.R. 3015, the National Coal Council Reestablishment Act, to reinvest in our natural resources.

Congressman Riley Moore is advocating for West Virginia in his role on the House Appropriations Committee.

- Directs FBI to review and to look for opportunities for expansion of FBI's Clarksburg CJIS facility.* ^{†1}
- Directs the EPA to brief Congress on the federal resources available to communities, including Wyoming and McDowell Counties, that have high prevalence of violations of drinking water regulations.* ^{†7}
- Provides robust funding for the operation and administration of the Black Lung Disability Trust Fund at \$90.5 million.* ^{†6}
- Restores funding to the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC), an invaluable resource for West Virginia that creates jobs, combats addiction, trains our workforce, and improves our state's infrastructure.* ^{†8}



- Transfers 72 acres of historic battlefield currently controlled by Customs and Border Patrol to the Harpers Ferry National Historical Park.
- Provides CBP with 25 acres of land which the National Park Service has deemed to have no historical value.
- Allows for the long-awaited expansion of the only facility in the nation capable of training CBP's management level agents.



When constituents are having an issue with a federal agency, Congressman Moore's casework team stands ready to assist. When the Congressman submits an inquiry to an agency such as the Social Security Administration (SSA), Internal Revenue Service (IRS), or the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), those agencies are required to respond.


